TOP

Remember to **HIDE IT, LOCK IT, KEEP IT.** Always lock your vehicle doors and keep valuables out of sight. Leaving mail and valuables in plain sight makes your vehicle a target for thieves, even when you park your vehicle in your own driveway, garage, or carport. Keep your homes and garages locked, even when you're at home. Bicycles should always be secured with a heavy-duty lock and chained to a solid object that the bicycle cannot be lifted over. Lock frame first, then back wheel and front wheel.

IF YOU SEE SOMETHING, SAY SOMETHING. Report suspicious activity in your neighborhood by calling the non-emergency dispatch line at 310-524-2750, or 9-1-1 right away. See the attached examples for identifying suspicious activity but always follow your instincts; if it doesn't look right, report it.
